RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The school hours are from 9:40 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. daily.
2. Habitual late comers will be sent home after three warning notes sent to the parent.
3. All the students must attend the morning Assembly.
4. Every student should bring pupil's diary to the school daily and make all entries upto date.
5. English should be spoken in the school premises to acquire proficiency in the language.
6. The students must be in the prescribed uniform on each day. Uniform must be maintained well and ironed properly.
7. Personal cleanliness, hygiene are expected from all students. The students found in the class room/ campus shabbily dressed or having unkempt and long/spiky/step cut hair will be sent out.
8. Wear Black sandals during rainy season.
9. Chappals (bathroom chappals) are not allowed in the school or for any outing.
10. Low waste and skinfit bottoms/pants and slim-fit tops are never allowed in the campus.
11. Chewing Gum, tobacco and other harmful products must not be brought or consumed in the school.
12. Pupils ought to be obedient, respectful to their parents, guardians and teachers.
13. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing in and circulating inside the school campus any periodicals, magazines, books (other than school books and library books) valuable articles like ornaments, money, electronic gadgets especially cell phones etc.

14. If students fall ill or unable to attend class during any working day he/she should submit the record of leave to the principal duly signed by his/her parent/guardian. The leave record in the school diary should always be up to date.
15. Student who has been continuously absent for three days is obliged to submit a medical certificate.
16. Children suffering from any infectious or contagious diseases should not be sent to school. The matter must immediately be brought to the school office.
17. The name of the students who have been continuously absent for 15 working days and who failed to apply for leave will be struck off rolls. Re-admission may be considered in accordance with the explanation given by the parent/guardian.
18. In the absence of a teacher, the class is expected to remain disciplined and silent under the guidance of the class leader and no student be seen loitering about during class hours.
19. Students should not go out of the Campus without permission of principal.
20. Students of one class should not enter other class unless instructed or permitted by the authority concerned.
21. Running or shouting inside the class room is forbidden.
22. No student shall stayback in the school premises after the school hours except when advised by principal/teachers.

23. The student who cause any damage to the school property will be severely dealt with. Upkeep of school property is the students responsibility. Any damage done will have to be made good by the parents.
24. Litter should be disposed only in dustbin kept in class room/at fixed places.
25. Homeworks shall be done and submitted regularly.
26. Any type of behaviour injurious to the moral tone of the school is sufficient reason for the dismissal for the student.
27. Parents should attend the parents meeting whenever it is convened.
28. The change of address of students should be informed to the school authorities in due time.
29. No student is allowed to go home during the school hours except for extreme necessity and escorted by guardian or on producing proper letter from parent or guardian.
30. Parents are always welcome to school to check up the progress of their children in studies etc.
This visit will serve a lot to strengthen parent- teacher relationship which is essential in education. But every one should see that this may not cause any disturbance to the regular functioning of the school.
31. Every student is expected to endeavour to attain academic excellence to improve moral values and to uphold the reputation of the school.

TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. Parents/Guardians are requested to glance through the diary daily.
2. Parents/Guardian should see that their wards respect the rules and regulations of the school.
3. Parents/Guardian should monitor the study habits, execution of home assignments etc. of their wards.
4. Parents/Guardians should ensure that their wards do not absent themselves from any test paper/ exam and that they are present on the reopening and closing days of the school.
5. Parents/Guardians should ensure that leave letters of their wards are sent to the principal on time.
6. Progress card/achievement records should be signed by the parent and returned to the class teacher promptly.
7. Parents/Guardians should respond to any message/request communicated by the teachers or the principal.
8. Communications regarding their wards should be written in the school diary. The wards are to be instructed to show the concerned teacher the message and get his/her signature.
9. Parents/Guardians are welcome to discuss with the principal matters related to the academic progress of their wards, with prior appointment with the principal.

10. Parents/Guardians must not approach teachers/students directly or disturb the class during study time. Permission from the principal has to be obtained before meeting any teacher.
11. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities for the improvement of the children. Suggestions for betterment are always welcome.
